## Attendance

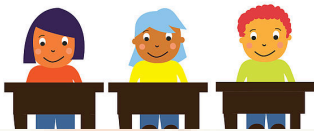
Please ensure that your child is present for class each day. Here are a few important reasons attendance is important:

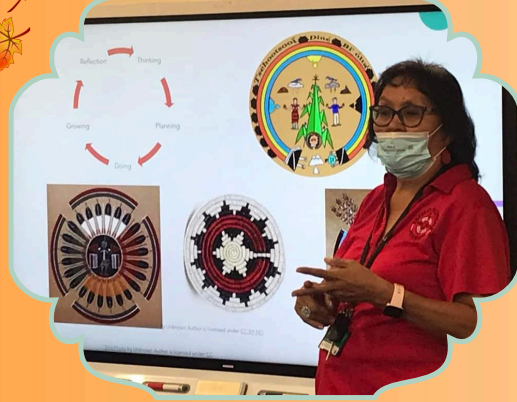
## 11 Reason Why Reading is Important For children

- 11-Develops a good self-image.

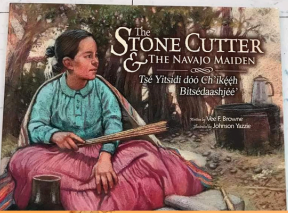
