

Freshman Merit Tuition Scholarship Criteria

The following scholarships can only be used at the Flagstaff Mountain Campus for Arizona residents only. Incoming freshman are automatically considered for scholarships once admitted. Students who qualify must accept their offer of admission at www.nau.edu/acceptmyoffer by May 1, 2021 in order to receive any merit scholarships.

Lumberjack Scholars Award

*Award Amount: Covers up to 100 percent of tuition; **does not cover fees or other expenses***

Award Criteria

- Minimum 3.50 unweighted core GPA or higher in the core 16 college preparatory courses
- No letter grade lower than a “B” earned in any of the required core 16 college preparatory courses
- No deficiencies (*missing or failed class*)
- 7th semester high school transcripts must be received by February 10th to verify eligibility
- Test scores cannot be used for eligibility

Retake Policy

- Students are allowed up to one (1) course retake
- Course retake must be completed by the time of high school graduation

Renewal Criteria

- Maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA in university course work

President’s Tuition Scholarship

Award Amount: \$8,000 per academic year

Award Criteria

- Minimum 3.50 unweighted core GPA or higher in the core 16 college preparatory courses

Renewal Criteria

- Maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA in university course work

Dean’s Tuition Scholarship

Award Amount: \$5,000 per academic year

Award Criteria

- 3.0-3.49 unweighted core GPA in the core 16 college preparatory courses

Renewal Criteria

- Maintain a 2.75 cumulative GPA in university course work

Opportunity Scholarship

Award Amount: \$2,500 per academic year

Award Criteria

- 2.90-2.99 unweighted core GPA in the core 16 college preparatory courses

Renewal Criteria

Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA in university course work

ACT/SAT scores are not required for merit scholarship considerations but may assist with additional scholarships money.

Additional Renewal Criteria: Students must be enrolled full time and complete 30 credit hours each academic year for renewal on all merit scholarships. The merit scholarships are all renewable for up to 4 years if renewal criteria are met. If the renewal criteria are not met, the amount and the award are subject to change.
