July 6, 2020	<b>Fall 2021 Application Opens</b> The freshman student application can be found online at <u>www.nau.edu/apply</u> . There is a \$25 application fee. Students will self-report their core college preparatory courses. We are test score optional, however, students can choose to self-report their ACT or SAT test scores (if available). Students should use a copy of their transcripts when completing the application to ensure they are providing accurate information.
Early Fall	Merit Scholarship Notification Students who have already been admitted will be notified via mail if they qualify for any merit tuition scholarships. This will be a continuous process throughout the year until May 1, 2021.
Early September	Honors Program Application Opens All student applicants to the Honors Program must submit an on-line Honors Application, a resume or list of activities and accomplishments, AND an Honors Essay of Admission. Early September	Housing Application Opens New students who have been admitted and paid the \$250 enrollment deposit will be able to complete the freshman housing application online at <u>www.nau.edu/reslife</u> . You will be required to further pay a \$100 housing application fee when applying for housing.
Mid Fall	<b>Priority Enrollment Profile Opens</b> Students who have been admitted and paid the \$250 enrollment deposit will be able to begin the enrollment process for their first semester by completing Priority Enrollment online at <u>www.nau.edu/priorityenrollment</u> . Please note that housing/ room selection is based on the completion of this profile.
October 1 <sup>st</sup>	FAFSA Opens Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid online at <u>www.fafsa.gov</u> . Be sure to list NAU on your application using school code: 001082
November 15 <sup>th</sup>	<b>NAU's FAFSA Priority Date</b> In order to guarantee you the most federal aid that you qualify for, we encourage you to submit your FAFSA by this date.
Late Fall/ Early Spring	<b>Financial Aid Packages Sent to Students</b> Students who submit their FAFSA by the November 15 <sup>th</sup> priority date will receive their financial aid award letter around winter break. This will be a continuous process throughout the school year after this date.
December - January	OSFA and Foundation Scholarship Applications Open Visit <u>http://nau.edu/Finaid/Aid-Types/Scholarships/</u> to find the online scholarship applications and more information on opening and closing dates.
February 10 <sup>th</sup>	Deadline to submit 7 <sup>th</sup> semester transcripts for Lumberjack Scholars Award Verification Students who have been awarded the Lumberjack Scholars Award or hope to receive this award, must submit an unofficial copy of their 7 <sup>th</sup> semester high school transcript by February 10 <sup>th</sup> in order to verify their eligibility. If students are awarded the Lumberjack Scholars Award after February 10 <sup>th</sup> , a 7 <sup>th</sup> semester transcript must be received within 7 business days. All 7 <sup>th</sup> semester transcripts must be sent via email directly to ljscholars@nau.edu for Lumberjack Scholarship verification purposes.
May 1 <sup>st</sup>	Accept your Offer to NAU Students must accept their offer of admission and pay the \$250 enrollment deposit by going to <u>www.nau.edu/acceptmyoffer</u> in order to receive any scholarships. The \$250 enrollment deposit is non- refundable after May 1 <sup>st</sup> .
