# How to Access the School Web Pages

## Internet Overview

You will need access to the internet to access your Window Rock High School classes this school year. Each student will need a device to access the internet that has a working browser.



### Access to the internet

- + **School Hot Spot locations** (Event Center parking lot, Window Rock High School parking lot, remote WRUSD bus hotspots)
- + **Community hotspot locations** (Window Rock Museum, Nihi Dine'e Ba Wellness Center)
- + **Choice Free Access** at home (NTUA) 928-212-0007

### Internet Browsers recommended

- + **Google Chrome**
- + **Firefox**

Each person may have a preference to which web browser, or search engine, they like to use. Sometimes it depends on whether or not you are using a desktop computer or laptop, tablet, or smartphone. For example if you have an Apple phone, and you use it for Internet access, most likely you will use Safari as your web browser. Sometimes some applications will not work as good on certain browsers and you may need to switch to another search engine or upgrade your browser. For example, if you have Google you may need to upgrade to Google Chrome.

- Canvas, Google Docs, Blackboard, APEX, PEG, Powerschool (use with Google Chrome or Firefox)


# Individual Teacher Web Pages

To find a teacher web page start at the school district website: <https://www.wrschool.net/>




Then at the top of the page, click **Our Schools** - choose **Window Rock High School** from the drop down menu
